Return to Basketball

Guidelines

- The Whitehorse Mustangs and relevant competitions (EDJBA, MEBA and GEBC) follow Basketball Victoria Guidelines for the Return to Basketball.

- Given we are primarily a junior club playing in junior competitions, we can only return to indoor competition at Orange 50 and Green 100 levels.



Orange 50

General Implementation Principles

- Separate entry/exit points
- Doors will be open to maximise airflow
- Break between sessions/games of 20 mins
- Attendees are not to enter if they are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms of COVID-19
- Attendees are to leave immediately on conclusion of session prior to attendees entering for next session
- Spectators are to physically distance (1.5m) at all times
- Wearing of face masks by spectators as per Victorian Government regulations
- Shaking of hands/high fives banned
- Mandatory COVID-19 Signage on display

Training Implementation Principles

Attendance Numbers:

- Max 20 players per court
- Coaches/Team Officials/Biosafety Officer max 3 per team
- Spectators Max 1 per player

Principles:

- Participant arrival time max 10 min prior no entry until previous group has left
- Hand sanitiser and wipes supplied to all coaches for use during training sessions
- Coach/Team Manager to wipe seating, and high touch points at the conclusion of the session
- Players to wipe basketballs prior to and at the end of session



Orange 50

Competition Implementation Principles

Attendance Numbers:

- Max 10 players per team
- Coaches/Team Officials Max 3 per team
- Venue Supervisors/Biosafety Officers Max 2 per venue
- Referees Max 2 per game
- Score Table Officials Max 1 per team
- Spectators Max 1 per player

Principles:

- Participant arrival time max 20 min prior no entry until previous groups have left
- Seating spaced 1.5m apart
- Score bench extended to allow physical distancing of scorers
- Hand sanitiser available on entry and at score bench
- Sanitisation of score table, seating, balls and high touch points to be carried out between games



Biosafety Officer

- The Biosafety Officer will be responsible for insuring compliance to the guidelines
- All participants and spectators are expected to contribute to compliance and follow the direction of the Biosafety Officer
- At trainings, the role of the Biosafety Officer will be fulfilled by the Team Managers
- At games, the role of the Biosafety Officer may be fulfilled by the Venue Manager or be a separate position



COVID-19 Infection Control Training

Department of Health

- All committee, administration staff, venue supervisors, biosafety officers, coaches and team managers within our club will undergo mandatory COVID-19 training from the Department of Health

- Training is optional for all other members of the club



Contact Tracing

Attendance Records

- Team Managers will keep a record of all players attending training
- Game scoring logs will keep a record of all players and coaches involved in each game
- Spectators are asked to sign in for attendance at all trainings and games
- Individual QR codes have been set up for each venue for electronic signing in via COVID Comply



Orchard Grove Primary School


- Entry
 - Through the side gate to the outside basketball courts
 - Enter through the glass doors
- Exit
 - Through the main northern door
- Barricades will be set up to separate the entry and exits
- Entry for the next game will not be allowed until the court has been cleared.
- There will be a 15-minute break between all training groups to reduce mixing of people.



VENUE COVID MAP - BHHS

Box Hill High School


- Entry via the front doors at the top of the stairs.
- Separate waiting zones are set up for each court.
 - BHHS1 east of the entry at the picnic tables
 - BHHS2 west of the entry doors
- BHHS2 will be let in first, making their way across the northern baseline to court 2.
- Exit via the south western fire escape door.
- BHHS2 will be cleared first followed by BHHS1.
- Entry for the next game will not be allowed until the courts have been cleared.




VENUE COVID MAP - SHPS

Surrey Hills Primary School

- Entry via the southern glass doors.
- Exit via the northern fire escape door and through the carpark.
- Venue is to be locked behind each group, including the car park (as long as it doesn't contain cars).
- There will be a 15-minute break between all training groups to reduce mixing of people.










SIGNAGE - ENTRY/EXIT
