WINTER 2025 REGISTRATION FEES

There is no change in registration fees for Winter 2025. The Committee continue to work hard to balance the need to be fiscally responsible with a firm commitment to keeping fees as low as possible so that we continue to offer one of the lowest fees of any club in the league and surrounding area. Payment of fees is your commitment to participate in the season. Refunds will not be given for withdrawal due to change of mind, team selection, scheduling issues or other commitments. Click [here](#) to view our Refund Policy.

Registration fees include all training and games, including finals. A 10% family discount is available for subsequent player registrations under the same account holder, **within the same competition and season**. If you have one child playing in the EDJBA and another in the GEBC Competition, the discount does not apply.

Annual Basketball Victoria (BV) Participant Licence and Basketball Australia (BA) Participant Fee will be automatically applied to your account at checkout when due for payment or renewal. It is important that you always register through this account going forward as the Annual Basketball Victoria Membership Fee will be linked to this account. Using different accounts will mean paying the annual fee each time. Late fees apply for registrations received after the 31st August and will only be accepted subject to availability. Late registrations require you to first contact the Registrar regarding vacancies for teams and, if available, a new registration link to that team will be provided.

AGE GROUPS

Age groups are determined by date of birth **and vary across competitions** (more information on Competitions in the next section). Please check the age group for the competition you're registering for.

If you want to be considered to play up an age group, you must note this on your registration form, including reasons to support your request, otherwise you will be placed according to your age. **Please note: requests will be subject to approval by the Team Selection Committee.**

COMPETITIONS

Primary Competition: EDJBA

The EDJBA is our primary competition. Players who register to the Club will be selected into a team to play in this competition. Mustangs field teams in all age groups. It is the largest junior domestic competition in Australia with games played on Saturdays from Park Orchards to Princes Hill, Bundoora to Box Hill.

Other Competitions: CBL and GEBC (Saturday) or MEBA (mid-week)

Mustangs field teams in the [CBL](#), [GEBC](#) or [MEBA](#) junior domestic competitions, subject to interest.

- CBL: Camberwell Basketball's local competition played on Saturdays from Bulleen to Ashburton, Richmond to Balwyn
- GEBC: Nunawading Basketball's competition played on Saturdays from Wantirna South to East Burwood, Mulgrave to Mitcham
- MEBA: Nunawading Basketball's local competition played mid-week from Wantirna South to East Burwood, Mulgrave to Mitcham

If you bring a custom team (U15s or older, minimum 7 players, coach, and team manager), or we receive sufficient interest to form a team, we can enter teams into the [CBL](#), [GEBC](#) or [MEBA](#) junior domestic competitions. To avoid confusion, information specific to those competitions will be provided separately, upon request.

REGISTRATION

[Registration](#) (and payment) is via PlayHQ. You will need to use your PlayHQ credentials to login, then click the relevant registration link to sign up for Winter Season. If you do not have a PlayHQ account, you will be required to set one up. This is a very simple process. This account is then used for all basketball competitions across Victoria for each season. It gives you the advantage of having all your basketball information in one place and the option of paying registration in instalments.

Parents will need to set up their PlayHQ account and can then attach dependent children to that account. Players that are 18 or older can manage their own accounts. You will be responsible for ensuring that all changes to personal details are updated in this account (eg phone number, email etc). You can also choose to make your name private or public. If you choose to make this private, your name will show as 'Private Player' on all scoring information on the website.

Once you have set up a PlayHQ account for yourself, you will then be able to register your child/ren and add them as dependents. Registration and payment is processed individually for each child.

TEAM SELECTION / PLAYER PLACEMENT

Our aim is to make sure all children have the opportunity to participate in basketball for enjoyment with the potential to thrive in a team appropriate to their skill level.

Friendship Requests

The Registrar together with the Team Selection Committee are responsible for allocating players to teams. If there are any friendship requests, these will be accommodated if the athletes are deemed to be of a reasonably similar level.

When considering friendship requests (maximum 2 per season) only reciprocated requests will be considered. While we do our best to accommodate, this is not always possible. See our [Team Selection Policy](#) for details. The more constraints a player has, the harder it is to place them in a team.

PLEASE keep requests to a minimum. This will assist our volunteers by reducing the complexity involved in selecting teams.

COACHING

Coach registration via PlayHQ has been made mandatory by Basketball Victoria. To register your intent to coach, use the same registration link, choosing Coach rather than player. You will be asked for preferences in gender and age group to assist us with assigning coaches. Coach registration is free. If you know anyone from outside of our club who may be interested, please feel free to pass this link onto them.

TEAM MANAGING

Coach registration via PlayHQ has been made mandatory by Basketball Victoria. Simply follow the same registration link, choosing Team Manager rather than player. You will be asked which child you would prefer to manage. Team manager registration is free.
